A follow-up to the Sermon on Prayer

A note to those who were not present for the sermon on prayer, please purchase a CD. The sermon began with a discussion about the disciples asking Jesus to teach them TO pray. They did not ask Him to teach them HOW to pray, but TO pray. We learned the Spirit of God is instructing us to learn TO pray not HOW to pray. The HOW will come when you learn TO pray. We must learn TO pray at all times, not just in times of trouble.

Learning TO pray is the key to learning HOW to pray. We must open our mouths and speak to God, He is our loving Father. I'm moved by the Spirit of God to invite you to pay attention to how many times you forget TO

pray. We get so busy during the day we may forget TO pray, especially over the things we routinely do.

Recipe Corner: Peach Cobbler

INGREDIENTS

2 cups fresh sliced peaches (or one 29 ounce can of sliced peaches, drained)

1 cup Bisquick mix

1 cup of milk

1/2 teaspoon nutmeg

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

1/2 cup butter, melted

1 cup of sugar

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 375 degrees Fahrenheit.

In an 8 x 8 baking dish, stir Bisquick mix, milk, nutmeg and cinnamon together until thoroughly mixed.

Stir in melted butter until crust is fully moistened.

In a medium mixing bowl, stir sugar and peaches.

Spoon peaches over the cobbler crust.

Bake for one hour or until crust is a golden brown. Serve warm and enjoy!
